1.0 Service Notes

The following changes have been made to H261

1. The release tape now contains two versions of H261. If installing on a DEC VAX, the version supporting the VAX will be loaded. Installation on a DEC Alpha will invoke the version of H261 which supports those platforms.
2. Four more qualifiers for the JOB card have been added to the DEC Alpha H261.
 - “/log” If specified, directs VMS to create a job log.
 - “/keep” If specified, directs that the job log file will be retained after it is printed.
 - “/noprint” If specified, directs VMS to not print the job log file.
 - “/notify” If specified, a VMS message will be broadcast to your terminal when the job has been completed or aborted.

2.0 TAR Status

No TARs were closed with this release.

3.0 Installation

A new version of the H261 manual was not released for H261 2.3. Please refer to the 2.2 H261 manual.

Step 3 (Run VMSINSTAL) on page 28, directs you to enter the command:

```
@SYS$UPDATE:VMSINSTAL H261022 MUA0:
```

The command must be modified for this release. Enter the command:

```
@SYS$UPDATE:VMSINSTAL H261023 MUA0:
```
