BFX Bulk File Transfer (H291) Release 3.0.3

BFX (H291) is a new version of an earlier product that uses NetEx/IP for the data transport.

The main features added with these products are the following:

- provide the support of the multi-host feature in H210IPz/TNP210 as a replacement for the NESiGate-LO device

OPERATIONAL/PROCEDURAL IMPACT

NetEx/IP functionality is provided by NetEx/IP running in a host NetEx via the TNP feature. There are no operational changes to NetEx applications (e.g. BFX and PFXT) to allow them to function with NetEx/IP in this configuration.
