HyperIP Release 6.1 is a feature release that provides support for Microsoft's Hyper-V hypervisor installations as well as VMware ESX(i) installations. HyperIP Release 6.1 is a mandatory upgrade for HyperIP Release 6.0.0 and 6.0.1. It is available from Network Executive Software by download, and is available as a no-charge upgrade to HyperIP customers of record.

This release supports installation and operation on Network Executive Software supplied hardware appliances as well as under VMware ESX(i) server systems and Microsoft Hyper-V server systems.

- 1) Include fixes provided by patches for prior releases.
- 2) Integrated Components for Windows Server 2008 Hyper-V
- 3) HyperIP for VMware installation via OVA (support for vSphere 4.0/5.0) & Tools upgrade
- 4) Reduce excessive CPU utilization for bandwidths less than 100Mb/s – additional tuning parameter for higher bandwidth requirements
- 5) New CLI commands to perform initial configuration
- 6) Raw TCPdump exports available
- 7) The layout of the Login web page changed for clarity
- 8) Improve TCP session detection
- 9) Improve management of HTTPS certifications
- 10) Security updates
- 11) Miscellaneous fixes

## OPERATIONAL/PROCEDURAL IMPACT

The following items highlight any operational or procedural issue(s):

- 1) Any customers running a release earlier than 6.0.1 should contact Netex Support for the upgrade procedure.
- 2) If you are upgrading from Release 6.0.1, you can download the image and install on the other partition of the hard drive, which is not currently running. Once installed, the new image can be subsequently started by selecting the other partition (and a configuration file) and rebooting the system. Once the new system is running it must be made permanent for it to run on subsequent reboots. No new license key should be required.

NOTE: Previous HyperIP versions may not have handled passwords with special characters properly. This may cause a situation where the current password will not allow the user to log in with 6.1 software. If your HyperIP password uses special characters, the password should be changed for the purpose of the upgrade to 6.1. Once the update is complete, change the password back to your desired password.

- 3) Default administrator (hipadmin) password is hipadmin. NetEx strongly recommends changing this password.

- 4) HyperIP Platform Serial Number is found on the Maintenance Page under Display Product Information and will be required when requesting the license key.
- 5) Because of current VMware ESX limitations, the documented usage of the USB port is not supported for VMware deployments and you must substitute alternative means for saving/restoring configurations, diagnostic dumps, etc.
