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PAM Distribution Utility (PAMDU) Release 1.0 is generally available and provides a mechanism for automatically distributing the NetEx/IP configuration data (NCT/PAMs) to NetEx/IP hosts. This utility supports zOS, Linux, Windows, HP-UX and Solaris NetEx/IP hosts. This release is available at no-charge to current (supported) NetEx/IP customers of record.

At the time of this announcement, PAMDU Release 1.0 supports installation and operation on S/390 systems that are running any supported level of z/OS up to z/OS V1R10, SuSE Linux, Windows Server 2008, HP-UX xxx, and Solaris xxx.
