Introduction

TPS200 Release 4.1 provides a base release of TPS200 for the TPF Operating System. This release provides support for NetEx/IP running as part of the NESiGate software on an IBM xSeries[®] appliance. The appliance uses an ESCON[®] channel for connectivity to S/390, and allows TPS200 to communicate with other TPS200 hosts over an IP network.

Installation Notes

TPS200 is distributed on a 3480 tape cartridge. The volume serial number is TPS200, and it contains the following two files:

File 1: DSN=TPSMAC,DCB=(RECFM=FB,LRECL=80,BLKSIZE=3120)

This file is an unloaded PDS containing the TPS macros.

File 2: DSN=TPSSRC,DCB=(RECFM=FB,LRECL=80,BLKSIZE=3120)

This file is an unloaded PDS containing the TPS source.

The TPSMAC library requires approximately 2 cylinders of 3390 disk storage.

The TPSSRC library requires approximately 8 cylinders of 3390 disk storage.
